DAY 1

Flight to Cleveland Ohio.

DAY 2

Go to the Behalt Historical Mural Cyclorama. Learn how the groups of the Amish and Mennonite were formed. Travel the counties stopping at a Quilt museum and shops that house all the fabric and sewing items you may need. Dinner at Old Order Amish home.

DAY 3

Tour of the canal town of Coshocton. Visit the Longaberger Basket Company and see the world's largest basket building!! Dinner.

DAY 4

Breakfast in an Amish home. View handmade quilts at another Amish home. Quilt show.

DAY 5

Tour of the area, quilt shops, meet an Amish lady at her home where she sells handmade quilts. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 6

Morning in Kidron at Lehman's hardware store and Hearthside quilt shop. Have a Haystack lunch which is popular with the Amish. We also have a speaker and see her collection of old quilts and designs. Tour a Victorian House museum. Dinner at an old Historic Stage Coach Inn.

DAY 7

Free Time. In the afternoon we will tour the "World Master carver of trains" – The Smithsonians called his work "Priceless work of Art" His wife collected over 73,000 buttons and arranged them into a quilt. Dinner at the Gallery.

DAY 8

Tour a local custom furniture business where a lot of Amish work. Also tour the German Culture Museum where artefacts from the time of the early Amish settlers are displayed. Dinner in an Amish home.

DAY 9

Today we travel back to the City of Cleveland for a night in the city where you can check out the Theaters, restaurants and shops.

Last minute shopping in Cleveland before our flight back to London.
