### **DAY 1**

To-day is the day of the Mennonite Relief sale and Quilt Auction it is a huge sale of food, crafts and quilts in an indoor and outdoor setting. Later we shall visit the Joseph Schneider Haus, Kithener's oldest land mark.

**DAY 7**

Today we will take a scenic tour of South Western Ontario, we will visit the shores of one of the Great Lakes have lunch and maybe a swim!!

**DAY 8**

This morning we travel to Niagara Falls via a visit to Crawford Lake a native village where we will have a guided tour. In the evening dinner overlooking the falls.
