Itinerary

DAY 1

Flight to Philadelphia. Overnight in Philadelphia.

DAY 2

Tour the Historic City of Philadelphia by trolley, visit Independence hall Liberty Bell Betsy Ross House.

DAY 3

Transfer to Lancaster, stopping en-route at Winterthur House Museum, to enjoy a private visit of their Quilt & Textile collection. Dinner.

DAY 4

We start with a visit to Intercourse the centre of the Amish area. Visit the Quilt & fabric shops that the Amish use. See the audio visual "Amish Experience" the story of Jacob. Dinner.

DAY 5

A day at the AQS Quilt Show which is the largest in Lancaster where you will find a display of wonderful quilts and lots of vendors offering a variety of merchandise. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 6

Second day at the Quilt Show in Lancaster. Dinner.

DAY 7

Brunch at the Eden Courtyard – experience the American way of eating!! Afternoon visit to Landis Valley farm Museum. Dinner.

DAY 8

The day starts with a visit to an Amish ladies Quilt & Fabric shop. Next stop is the lovely town of Lititz where you will be able to get lunch and a visit to the Country Store Museum. Later we then visit 2 more fabric shops- each one bigger than the last!! Dinner.

DAY 9

Today we will visit Wengar Gallery to meet with an Amish Artist. Afterwards our next stop will be the Tangar Outlet Mall where you will find designer labels all at discount prices. In the afternoon we have a guided tour around the Amish Farmlands where we shall see farms and businesses run by the Amish. Ending with dinner with an Amish family in their home. Not to be missed- a truly unforgettable experience.

DAY 10

Our last morning we will have a guided tour of “Wheatland” the home of James Buchanan – the 15th President of the USA. We will then just have time for that last minute shopping in Intercourse for the last chance to pick up that piece of fabric you can’t do without!! Next is the airport for our evening flight back to London.
